

## **THE DANCE CURRENT**

### **“FOUR TICKETS TO DJD’S JULIET + ROMEO AT FIRSTONTARIO PAC”**

#### **OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. No purchase necessary. To be eligible to win a prize in the “Four Tickets to DJD’s Juliet + Romeo at FirstOntario Performing Arts Centre” contest (the “Contest”), a participant must be a legal resident of Canada, excluding the Province of Quebec, and must, at the commencement of the Contest Period be of the age of majority in his or her province of residence. Any potential participant who is an employee, representative and/or agent of Dance Media Group/Groupe Danse Média (“Sponsor”), its affiliated companies, advertising agencies, prize suppliers or other representatives or agents (the “Sponsor-related Parties”), or a member of the respective immediate families (which for the purpose of these rules shall be defined to mean parent, child, spouse or sibling) of such persons or anyone with whom such persons are domiciled is ineligible to participate in this Contest.
2. The Contest will run as follows: opening 12:00 a.m. Eastern Time (“ET”) on October 28, 2019, and closing at 11:59 p.m. ET on November 10, 2019 (this time period being the “Contest Period”).
3. Assuming a participant meets all of the eligibility criteria set out above, the participant can enter online at [www.thedancecurrent.com](http://www.thedancecurrent.com) (the “Site”) during the Contest Period by fully completing the entry form on the Site. Only one (1) entry into the Contest per person/per household/per email account will be accepted and eligible. Entries made with multiple addresses, under multiple identities, or through the use of any device or artifice to enter multiple times (in breach of these rules), or entries that are in excess of the permitted number of entries during the Contest period are automatically void. Contest entries obtained through unauthorized sources or that are incomplete, illegible, mutilated, altered, reproduced, forged, irregular or fraudulent in any way or otherwise not in compliance with these rules are automatically void. Sponsor may verify the validity of entries at any time in its discretion.

A random draw from all eligible entries will be held at the offices of the Sponsor in Toronto, Ontario, on November 11, 2019, at 12:00 p.m. ET or as soon thereafter as is possible.

Selected participants will be notified by email to the participant’s e-mail address provided on the entry form, or by telephone at the number provided on the entry form, within seven (7) days of the draw and, prior to being declared a winner, will be required to correctly answer, unaided and without mechanical or electronic assistance, a time-limited, mathematical, skill-testing question.

If a selected participant is unable to correctly answer the skill-testing question, cannot be reached by e-mail or phone within forty-eight (48) hours of the draw, or otherwise does not meet all contest conditions and/or fully comply with these Contest rules, his or her prize will be forfeited and another entrant will be drawn from the remaining eligible entries.
7. There is one (1) prize (the "Prize") available to be won in this Contest, being four tickets to Juliet + Romeo at FirstOntario Performing Arts Centre, with a total approximate retail value of CDN\$220.00.
8. Awarded prizes will be delivered by mail or courier within eight (8) weeks of Sponsor's confirmation of the winner. Any costs or expenses incurred by the winner in claiming or using the Prize are the responsibility of the winner. The Prize is non-transferable and no cash alternatives will be provided. The Sponsor reserves the right to substitute the Prize described above with a prize of equal or greater value.
